In the United Kingdom and some Commonwealth countries, the local laws established by municipalities are referred to as by(e)-laws because their scope is regulated by the central governments of those nations. Accordingly, a bylaw enforcement officer is the Canadian equivalent of the American code enforcement officer or municipal regulations enforcement officer. In the United States, the federal government and most state governments have no direct ability to regulate the single provisions of municipal law. As a result, terms such as code, ordinance, or regulation, if not simply law, are more common. Originally founded in 1889, it is among the oldest law faculties in Canada. The school was reorganized in the early 1950s into a modern professional faculty, and its Juris Doctor degree replaced the Bachelor of Laws (LLB) in 2001. Originally named the University of Toronto Faculty of Law, the school was renamed after alumnus Henry N.R. Jackman in September 2025, following his CA\$80 million donation to the school. == History == An example where Henry's law is at play is the depth-dependent dissolution of oxygen and nitrogen in the blood of underwater divers that changes during decompression, possibly causing decompression sickness if the decompression happens too quickly. An everyday example is carbonated soft drinks, which contain dissolved carbon dioxide. Before opening, the gas above the drink in its container is almost pure carbon dioxide, at a pressure higher than atmospheric pressure. After the bottle is opened, this gas escapes, thus decreasing the pressure above the liquid, resulting in degassing as the dissolved carbon dioxide is liberated from the solution.

Although the common law has, historically, been the foundation and prime source of English law, the most authoritative law is statutory legislation, which comprises Acts of Parliament, regulations and by-laws. In the absence of any statutory law, the common law with its principle of stare decisis forms the residual source of law, based on judicial decisions, custom, and usage.

Law and economics The field emerged in the United States in the early 1960s, primarily through the work of scholars from the Chicago school of economics, such as Aaron Director, George Stigler, and Ronald Coase, and jurists, including Guido Calabresi. The second branch focuses on an institutional analysis of law and legal institutions, with a broader focus on economic, political, and social outcomes, and overlapping with analyses of the institutions of politics and governance. Law and economics, or economic analysis of law, is the application of microeconomic theory to the analysis of legal rules and institutions. There are two major branches of law and economics. One is based on applying the methods and theories of neoclassical economics to the positive and normative analysis of the law.
