auriculotherapy in 1957. Nogier developed a phrenological method of projection of a fetal Homunculus on the ear and published what he called the "Vascular Autonomic Signal" which measured a change in the amplitude of the pulse. That mechanism would only produce a signal upon the introduction of new information to the electromagnetic field of the patient. Nogier cited a 'principle of matching resonance' which he could use the vascular autonomic signal to detect...

Platelet-rich plasma (PRP) can be combined with collagen induction therapy treatment in a form of dermatologic autologous blood therapy. PRP is derived from the patient's own blood and may contain growth factors that increase collagen production. It can be applied topically to the entire treatment area during and after collagen induction therapy treatments or injected intradermally to scars. Efficacy of the combined treatments remains in question pending scientific studies. dcfc69f3aa Hair transplantation can also be used to restore eyelashes, eyebrows, beard hair, chest hair, pubic hair and to fill in scars caused by accidents or surgery such as face-lifts and previous hair transplants. Hair transplantation differs from skin grafting in that grafts contain almost all of the epidermis and dermis surrounding the hair follicle, and many tiny grafts are transplanted rather than a single strip of skin. dcfc69f3aa Knitting creates stitches: loops of yarn in a row. When done by hand, the loops are created with a pair of knitting needles where the loops are created one at a time. Follicular unit transplantation FUT is considered an advance over older hair transplantation procedures that used larger grafts and often produced a pluggy, unnatural look. In a properly performed follicular unit transplant, the results will mimic the way hair grows in nature and will be undetectable as a hair transplant. Follicular units also contain sebaceous (oil) glands, nerves, a small muscle, and occasional fine vellus hairs. Topical drug delivery The wide use of topical drugs leads to the advancement in topical drug delivery. On the other hand, physical agents, like micro-needles is other approach for enhancement of absorption. The delivery of topical drugs needs to pass through multiple skin layers and undergo pharmacokinetics, hence factor like dermal diseases minimize the bioavailability of the topical drugs. In these ancient cities, topical medications like ointments and potions were used on the skin. Historically, topical route was the first route of medication used to deliver drugs in humans in ancient Egyptian and Babylonian in 3000 BCE. These advancements are used to enhance the delivery of topical medications to the skin by using chemical and physical agents. Besides using carriers, other factors **Topical drug delivery (TDD)** is a route of drug administration that allows the topical formulation to be delivered across the skin upon application, hence producing a localized effect to treat skin disorders like eczema. The formulation of topical drugs can be classified into corticosteroids, antibiotics, antiseptics, and anti-fungal. The mechanism of topical delivery includes the diffusion and metabolism of drugs in the skin. topical drugs. Hand knitting needles are either straight and cylindrical or in the round with plastic tubes or wire (cables) joining the ends of both. Knitted fabric consists of a number of consecutive rows of connected loops that intermesh with the next and previous rows. As each row is formed, each newly created loop is pulled through one or more loops from the prior row and placed on the 'gaining needle' (the needle that is receiving newly created stitches) so that the loops from the prior row can be pulled off the other needle without unraveling. dcfc69f3aa **Differences in yarn** (varying in fiber type, weight, uniformity, twist, needle size, and stitch type) allow for a variety of knitted fabrics with different properties, including color, texture, thickness, heat retention, water resistance, and integrity...

Hair transplantation In this minimally invasive procedure, grafts containing hair follicles that are genetically resistant to balding (like the back of the head) are transplanted to the bald scalp. The technique is primarily used to treat male pattern baldness. harvesting, individual follicular units containing 1 to 4 hairs are removed under local anesthesia; this micro removal typically uses tiny punches of between 0.5 to 1.0 mm. **Hair transplantation** is a surgical technique that removes hair follicles from one part of the body, called the 'donor site', to a bald or balding part of the body known as the 'recipient site' dcfc69f3aa

Microblading Microblading deposits pigment into the upper region of the dermis, so it fades more rapidly than machine tattooing techniques. Microblading is also

referred to as eyebrow embroidery, eyebrow feathering, microstroking, 3D eyebrows, nanoblading or hair-like strokes. Eyebrow tattooing was originally developed for eyebrow restoration, as a medical tattoo to minimize the appearance of hair loss in Microblading is a tattoo technique used on eyebrows to create, enhance, or alter their shape and color. To apply this form of semi-permanent makeup, a technician uses a small handheld tool made of several tiny needles to add semi-permanent pigment to the skin. Microblading differs from the most common process of tattooing as each hair stroke is created by hand with a tiny needle that creates fine slices in the skin, whereas eyebrow tattoos are done with a tattoo machine

A hair weave is a human or artificial hair utilized for integration with one's natural hair. Weaves can alter one's appearance for long or short periods of time by adding further hair to one's natural hair or by covering the natural hair together with human or synthetic hairpieces. Weaving additional human or synthetic pieces can enhance one's hair by giving it volume and length, and by adding color without the damage of chemicals or by adopting a different hair texture than that of their own. However, hair loss can occur either along the front hairline or above the ears due to the wearing of specific... It is a technique for which research is ongoing, but has been used for a number of skin problems including scarring and acne. Some studies have also shown that when combined with minoxidil treatment, microneedling is able to treat hair loss more effectively than minoxidil treatment alone.

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
