Comprehensive metabolic panel Alanine amino transferase (ALT or SGPT) The National Institutes of Health provides ranges considered within normal limits, though optimal levels may vary The comprehensive metabolic panel, or chemical screen (CMP; CPT code 80053), is a panel of 14 blood tests that serves as an initial broad medical screening tool. The CMP provides a rough check of kidney function, liver function, diabetic and parathyroid status, and electrolyte and fluid balance 207f0d26c0

Reference ranges for blood tests A reference range is usually defined as the set of values 95 percent of the normal population Reference ranges (reference intervals) for blood tests are sets of values used by a health professional to interpret a set of medical test results from blood samples. reference range provided by the laboratory that performed the test. Side effects of bicalutamide The most common side effects of bicalutamide monotherapy in men include breast tenderness, breast growth, feminization, demasculinization, and hot flashes. test result (SGOT or SGPT) that exceeded twice the ULN. Bicalutamide is well tolerated and has few side effects in women. Less common side effects of bicalutamide monotherapy in men include sexual dysfunction, depression, fatigue, weakness, and anemia. General side effects of bicalutamide that may occur in either sex include diarrhea, constipation, abdominal pain, nausea, dry skin, itching, and rash. The CMP is an expanded version of the basic metabolic panel (BMP), which does not include liver tests. A CMP (or BMP) can be ordered as part of a routine physical examination, or may be used to monitor a patient with a chronic disease, such as diabetes mellitus or hypertension. 207f0d26c0 Also known as SMA12+2 test, the CMP has previously been known as Chem 12, Chemistry panel, Chemistry screen, SMA 12, SMA 20 and SMAC (Sequential Multiple Analysis - Computer). Abnormal values from a CMP are often the result of false positives and thus the CMP may need to be repeated (or a more specific test performed), requiring a second blood drawing procedure and possibly additional expense for the patient, even though no disease is present. 207f0d26c0 == Testing == 207f0d26c0

Gilbert's syndrome Crigler-Najjar syndrome (types I and II), a different glucuronyl Gilbert's syndrome (GS) is a syndrome in which the liver of affected individuals processes bilirubin more slowly than the majority, resulting in higher levels in the blood. the liver enzymes ALT/SGPT and AST/SGOT, as well as albumin, are within normal ranges. Many people never have symptoms. Occasionally jaundice (a yellowing of the skin or whites of the eyes) may occur 207f0d26c0

Gilbert syndrome is due to a genetic variant in the UGT1A1 gene, which results in decreased activity of the bilirubin uridine diphosphate glucuronosyltransferase (UGT1A1) enzyme. It is typically inherited in an autosomal recessive pattern and occasionally in an autosomal dominant pattern depending on the type of variant. Episodes of jaundice may be triggered by stress such as exercise, menstruation, or not eating. Diagnosis is based on elevated levels of unconjugated bilirubin in the blood without signs of liver problems or red blood cell breakdown. 207f0d26c0 == Interpretation == 207f0d26c0 A reference range is usually defined as the set of values 95 percent of the normal population falls within (that is, 95% prediction interval). It is determined by collecting data from vast numbers of laboratory tests. 207f0d26c0 Blood test results should always be interpreted using the reference range provided by the laboratory that performed the test. 207f0d26c0 == Pathophysiology == 207f0d26c0 Most liver diseases cause only mild symptoms initially, but these diseases must be detected early. Hepatic (liver) involvement in some diseases can be of crucial importance. This testing is performed on a patient's blood sample. Some tests are associated with functionality (e.g., albumin), some with cellular integrity (e.g., transaminase), and some with conditions linked to the biliary tract (gamma-glutamyl transferase and alkaline phosphatase). Because some of these tests do not measure function, it is more accurate to call these liver chemistries or liver tests rather than liver function tests. 207f0d26c0

Liver function tests bilirubin (direct and indirect), and others. These tests include prothrombin time (PT/INR), activated partial thromboplastin time (aPTT), albumin, bilirubin (direct and indirect), and others. Gilbert syndrome is associated with decreased cardiovascular health risks but increased

Elevated transaminases Mild transaminasemia refers to levels up to 250 U/L. Cirrhosis of the liver or fulminant liver failure secondary to hepatitis commonly reach values for both ALT and AST in the >1000 U/L range; however, many people with liver disease have normal transaminases. Other terms include transaminasemia, and elevated liver enzymes (though they are not the only enzymes in the liver).
