In general, EIS are enterprise-wide DSS which help top-level executives analyze, compare, and highlight trends in important variables so that they can monitor performance and identify opportunities and problems. EIS and data warehousing technologies are converging in the marketplace. 2ba4c03b7e Early 2006: ECM tools and strategies allowed the management of an organization's unstructured information, wherever that information exists. 2ba4c03b7e The term EIS lost popularity in favor of business intelligence (with the sub areas of reporting, analytics, and digital dashboards). 2ba4c03b7e In a corporate setting, the ultimate goal of a management information system is to increase the value and profitability of the business by providing managers with timely and relevant information for informed decision-making. 2ba4c03b7e Security technologies, and threats, can evolve much more quickly than regulatory bodies; so the CSMS emphasises a system of technologies and processes which can adapt more quickly, without relying on a narrowly defined list of technical controls in a standard. Consequently, the CSMS is intended to be technology-neutral, much like ISO 27001, unlike detailed technical security standards such as PCI DSS. 2ba4c03b7e Key management concerns keys at the user level, either between users or systems. This is in contrast to key scheduling, which typically refers to the internal handling of keys within the operation of a cipher. 2ba4c03b7e The term Management Information Systems (MIS) broadly refers to organized systems that support the collection, processing, storage, and analysis of data for managerial purposes within an organization. Common functions of an MIS include decision support, transaction processing, reporting, and performance monitoring. The term generally excludes systems focused solely on software infrastructure or technical operations, distinguishing MIS from broader information technology management. 2ba4c03b7e Traditionally, executive information systems were mainframe computer-based programs. SIEM systems log security events and generate reports to meet regulatory frameworks such as the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI DSS). PCI DSS includes guidelines regarding components of organizations' technical and operational system that are related to such data The Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI DSS) is a global data security standard that regulates how entities store, process, and transmit cardholder data (CHD) and/or sensitive authentication data (SAD). PCI DSS includes guidelines regarding components of organizations' technical and operational system that are related to such data. This standard is administered by the Payment Card Industry Security Standards Council, and its use is enforced by the major payment card brands. Sensitive authentication data refers to information including "full track data (magnetic-stripe data or equivalent on a chip)," card verification codes, and PINs/PIN blocks. authentication data (SAD). Cardholder Data refers to information including Primary Account Numbers (PAN), cardholder names, expiration dates, and service codes. These organizations, including merchants and service providers, must prove compliance to the PCI DSS through an assessment and validation process 2ba4c03b7e

ARGOS improves situation awareness, facilitates decision support, and information sharing among the emergency response organizations. Security information and event management (SIEM) is a field within computer security that combines security information management (SIM) and security event management (SEM) to enable real-time analysis of security alerts generated by applications and network hardware. SIEM technology collects and aggregates data from various systems, allowing organizations to meet compliance requirements while safeguarding against threats. NIST's definition for a SIEM tool is an application that provides the ability to gather security data from information system components and present that data as actionable information via a single interface 2ba4c03b7e
