In most episodes of low back pain a specific underlying cause is not identified or even looked for: the pain is believed to be due to mechanical problems such as muscle or joint strain. To estimate how likely it is that an animal can feel pain, they look for the presence of nociception and a complex nervous system, behavioural evidence such as grooming, or whether analgesics have effects. According to the U.S. National Research Council Committee on Recognition and Alleviation of Pain in Laboratory Animals, pain is experienced by many animal species, including mammals and possibly all vertebrates. including opioid and non-opioid drugs, cognitive behavioral therapy and physical therapy are the most common interventions. Medications such as aspirin and ibuprofen are used for mild pain whereas morphine and codeine are prescribed for severe pain. TENS, by definition, covers the complete range of transcutaneously applied currents used for nerve excitation, but the term is often used with a more restrictive intent, namely, to describe the kind of pulses produced by portable stimulators used to reduce pain. A typical battery-operated TENS unit is able to modulate pulse width, frequency, and intensity. Intensity of stimulation should be strong but comfortable with greater intensities, regardless of frequency, producing the greatest analgesia. Generally, TENS is applied at high frequency (>50 Hz) with an intensity below motor contraction (sensory intensity) or low frequency (<10 Hz) with an intensity that produces motor contraction. The unit is usually connected to the skin using two or more electrodes which are typically conductive gel pads 6cb8c806ef
