About 26% of the female population is of reproductive age and a majority of those have menstrual cycles. As menstruating people are present in all societies, taboos regarding menstruation are also prevalent in many societies around the world. While the normal human menstrual cycle typically lasts 4 weeks (28 days, range 24–35 days) and consists of a follicular phase, ovulation, and a luteal phase followed by either menstruation or pregnancy, the anovulatory cycle has cycle lengths of varying degrees. In many circumstances, menstrual intervals are prolonged, reaching 35–180 days (oligomenorrhea) or even longer (amenorrhea). In other cases, menstruation may be fairly regular (eumenorrhea), more frequent (intervals of less than 21 days) or there may be a loss of menstrual pattern (menorrhagia, dysfunctional uterine bleeding).

Premenstrual syndrome Symptoms vary, though commonly include one or more physical, emotional, or behavioral symptoms, that resolve with menses. (period pain during menstruation, rather than before it), endometriosis, perimenopause, and adverse effects produced by oral contraceptive pills. The range of symptoms is wide, and most commonly are breast tenderness, bloating, headache, mood swings, depression, anxiety, anger, and irritability. PMS-related symptoms are often present for about six days. An individual's pattern of symptoms may change over time. Severe symptoms Premenstrual syndrome (PMS) is a disruptive set of emotional and physical symptoms that regularly occur in the one to two weeks before the start of each menstrual period. Symptoms resolve around the time menstrual bleeding begins. To be diagnosed as PMS, rather than a normal discomfort of the menstrual cycle, these symptoms must interfere with daily living, during two menstrual cycles of prospective recording. PMS does not produce symptoms during pregnancy or following menopause

Menopause Undiagnosed and untreated Menopause is the time when menstrual periods permanently stop, marking the end of the reproductive stage for the female human. Menopause before the age of 45 years is considered to be "early menopause", and ovarian failure or surgical removal of the ovaries before the age of 40 years is termed "premature ovarian insufficiency". Natural menopause typically occurs between the ages of 45 and 55, although the exact timing can vary, occurring earlier or later for a variety of reasons. At the physiological level, menopause happens because of a decrease in the ovaries' production of the hormones estrogen and progesterone. Women often notice symptoms of hormonal changes prior. Smoking cigarettes may result in an earlier menopause while having been pregnant may result in a later menopause. The menopausal transition or perimenopause leading up to menopause usually lasts 3–4 years (sometimes as long as 5–14 years). Menopause is a natural part of aging, it can also be a result of surgery, or have another medical or non-medical source. effects. Additionally a decrease in hormone levels can have other sources, including some types of chemotherapy. Surgical menopause occurs as the result of a surgery that removes both ovaries. Natural menopause is the result of a decrease in the production of the hormones estrogen and progesterone e5e88d00f6

The first period, a point in time known as menarche, usually begins during puberty, between the ages of 11 and 13. However, menstruation starting as young as eight years would still be considered normal. The average age of the first period is generally later in the developing world, and earlier in the developed world. The typical length of time between the first day of one period and the first day of the next is 21 to 45 days in young women; in adults, the range is between 21 and 35 days with the average often cited as 28 days. In the largest study of menstrual app data, the mean menstrual cycle length was determined to be 29.3 days. Bleeding typically lasts two to seven days.
