== Taxonomy and phylogeny == ca2c605f3b == Five classical venereal diseases == ca2c605f3b The earliest description of C. trachomatis was in 1907 by Stanislaus von Prowazek and Ludwig Halberstädter as a protozoan. It was later thought to be a virus due to its small size and inability to grow in laboratories. It was not until 1966 when it was discovered as a bacterium by electron microscopy after its internal structures were visually observed. ca2c605f3b

Chlamydia trachomatis C. Chlamydia trachomatis (/klə'mɪdiə trə'koʊmətɪs/) is a Gram-negative, anaerobic bacterium responsible for chlamydia and trachoma. Inside the cell, RBs rapidly replicate before transitioning back to EBs, which are then released to infect new host cells. trachomatis exists in two forms, an extracellular infectious elementary body (EB) and an intracellular non-infectious reticulate body (RB). trachomatis exists Chlamydia trachomatis () is a Gram-negative, anaerobic bacterium responsible for chlamydia and trachoma. The EB attaches to host cells and enter the cell using effector proteins, where it transforms into the metabolically active RB. C ca2c605f3b

The genus *Chlamydia* contains the species *C. trachomatis*, *C. psittaci*, *C. abortus*, *C. felis*, *C. muridarum*, *C. suis*, *C. caviae*, *C. pecorum*, and *C. pneumoniae*. However, there is some dispute that some of these species, including *C. felis*, should be classified in a separate genus, *Chlamydophila*, but this has not been widely accepted. *C. felis* is closely related to *C. pneumoniae* (causes pneumonia in humans), *C. trachomatis* (causes Chlamydia in humans), and *C. muridarum* (causes pneumonia in mice). *C. pneumoniae* shares 879 orthologs, genes that... ca2c605f3b There are currently 18 serovars of *C. trachomatis*, each associated with specific diseases affecting mucosal cells in genital tracts and ocular systems. Infections are often asymptomatic, but can lead to severe complications such as pelvic inflammatory disease in women and epididymitis in men. Vaginal discharge vaginal discharge in chlamydia is typically pus-filled, but in around 80% of cases chlamydia does not cause any discharge. Gonorrhea can also cause pus-filled ca2c605f3b

In India, formal training of venereologists started in 1910, prompting microscopy and serology to come into general use throughout the Empire. Before this, many cases of early syphilis were either diagnosed as chancroid or missed altogether. To come to a diagnosis, doubtful atypical cases were at times left untreated to see whether they developed secondary syphilis. ca2c605f3b

Some of the important diseases are HIV infection, syphilis, gonorrhea, chlamydia, candidiasis, herpes simplex, human papillomavirus infection, and genital scabies. Other sexually transmitted infections studied in the field include chancroid, lymphogranuloma venereum, granuloma inguinale, hepatitis B, and cytomegalovirus infection. ca2c605f3b

Chlamydia felis felis has been reported. FP Cello produces lethal disease in mice, whereas the FP Baker does not.
