Serotonin-norepinephrine reuptake inhibitor In some studies, SNRIs demonstrated slightly higher Serotonin-norepinephrine reuptake inhibitors (SNRIs) are a class of antidepressant medications used to treat major depressive disorder (MDD), anxiety disorders, chronic neuropathic pain, fibromyalgia, and menopausal symptoms. SNRIs are monoamine reuptake inhibitors; specifically, they inhibit the reuptake of serotonin and norepinephrine. SNRIs can be contrasted with the selective serotonin reuptake inhibitors (SSRIs) and norepinephrine reuptake inhibitors (NRIs), which act upon single neurotransmitters. Off-label uses include treatments for attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) and obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD). This translates to the 2nd- and 3rd-most-common antidepressants, behind Lexapro (escitalopram), an SSRI. Since norepinephrine pathways play a role in pain modulation, SNRIs are also widely used for chronic pain conditions such as neuropathic pain and fibromyalgia. While pharmaceutical companies have justified the development of me-toos as offering incremental improvements in efficacy, side-effects, compliance and cost, critics have questioned the increasing marketing of me-toos, their absorption of research and development resources and their impact on the innovation of new treatments. biologically active

Initially it referred only to specific sexual needs, but he later expanded the concept to a universal desire, with the id being its "great reservoir".
