way to solve emotional problems. can lead to being pathologically fixated in the Child and Parent ego states, bringing discomfort to an individual and/or others in a variety of forms Transactional analysis is a psychoanalytic theory and method of therapy wherein social interactions (or "transactions") are analyzed to determine the ego state of the communicator (whether parent-like, childlike, or adult-like) as a basis for understanding behavior. The method deviates from Freudian psychoanalysis, which focuses on increasing awareness of the contents of subconsciously held ideas. Eric Berne developed the concept and paradigm of transactional analysis in the late 1950s 069fced92a

If the demand cannot be avoided, a panic attack or a meltdown may ensue. PDA is thought to involve a highly sensitive nervous system in which perceived threats—particularly demands or limits on autonomy—can trigger fight, flight, or freeze responses, even when those threats are not obvious to others. As it is not recognized as an independent syndrome, PDA is not included in criteria or diagnoses listed in the International Classification of Diseases (ICD-11) or the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders 069fced92a

People with DPD depend excessively on others for advice, decision-making and the fulfillment of other needs, as they lack confidence in their abilities, competence and judgment. They may thus act

A number of studies demonstrate considerable efficacy in using CR-based therapies. CR employs many strategies, such as Socratic questioning, thought recording, and guided imagery, and is used in many types of therapies, including cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT) and rational emotive behaviour therapy (REBT)

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Dependent personality disorder personality disorder, as manifested in both a general impairment in personality functioning along with at least one pathological personality trait. Individuals with DPD often struggle to make independent decisions and seek constant reassurance from others. The World Dependent personality disorder (DPD) is a personality disorder characterized by a pervasive dependence on other people and subsequent submissiveness and clinginess. This dependence can result in a tendency to prioritize the needs and opinions of others over their own. This personality disorder is a long-term condition in which people depend on others to meet their emotional and physical needs

In the latest edition of the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders (DSM-5-TR, 2022),

dependent personality disorder is classified as a cluster C ("anxious or fearful") personality disorder. There was a diagnostic category for DPD in the previous revision of the International classification of Diseases, ICD-10; but the ICD-11 no longer has distinct diagnoses for personality disorders. 069fced92a

== Overview == 069fced92a Cognitive restructuring involves four steps: 069fced92a Hans Selye (1974) proposed four variations of stress. On one axis, he locates good stress (eustress) and bad stress (distress). On the other is over-stress (hyperstress) and understress (hypostress).
