

Describe The Process Of Oogenesis

L. arboreum is commonly found in the Red Sea. A 1997 reef transect study showed that octocorals, such as *L. arboreum*, compose under 20% of soft coral coverage on both reef flats, and the upper fore-reefs in the Gulf of Umm al-Rashrash, off the East coast of the Sinai Peninsula. Typically in Gulf of Umm al-Rashrash reefs, octocoral coverage is dominated by carpets of a few species. A possible explanation for this extensive, monospecific coverage is periods of rapid growth. *L. arboreum* is not typically one of these dominant octocorals, but can compose up to 36% of living soft coral coverage... Two separate forms of *Patiriella regularis* have been identified. The most significant difference between the two is the plate arrangement along the ray crests. They typically grow up to 10 cm (3.9 in) across in diameter, although their sizes vary greatly within the species. In order for human reproduction to be achieved, an individual must undergo puberty first, requiring ovulation in females and the spermatheca in males to have... == Ecology == Contrary to male spermatogenesis, which can last indefinitely, folliculogenesis ends when the remaining follicles in the ovaries are incapable of responding to the hormonal cues that previously recruited some follicles to mature. This depletion in follicle supply signals the beginning of menopause. While normal cells contain 46 chromosomes (23 pairs), gamete cells contain only half that number, and it is when these two cells merge into one combined zygote cell that genetic recombination occurs. The zygote then undergoes a defined development process that is known as human embryogenesis, and this starts the typical 38-week gestation period for the embryo (and eventually fetus) that is followed by childbirth.

The type of gamete an organism produces determines its sex and sets the basis for the sexual roles and sexual selection. Female gametes are called ova or egg cells, and male gametes are called sperm. In the majority of species, the gametes are of different sizes, a condition known as anisogamy or heterogamy that applies to humans and other mammals. For example, the human ovum has approximately 100,000 times the volume of a single human sperm cell. Sperm cells are motile due to the presence of a tail-shaped structure, the flagellum, that provides propulsion. In contrast, each egg cell or ovum is comparably large and non-motile. Patiriella regularis is a spinulosan asterinid with a pentagonal shape. It typically has five short arms, however, 2% of the population is composed of individuals with 4, 6, 7 or 8 arms. It has an arm spread of up to 60 mm (2.4 in). The colour of *Patiriella regularis* differs greatly between individuals and includes blues, greens and browns as the more common colours,

although oranges, reds and individuals with mottled forms have also been identified. *D. unisexualis* is capable of parthenogenetic reproduction by oogenesis in female only lineages. During the prophase I stage of meiosis homeologous chromosomes (originally inherited from two different parental species) undergo synapsis. A protein MLH1 employed in DNA mismatch repair also appears to be involved in this meiotic process. Early life and education == Biological and legal requirements == This species is found in the Pacific Coast of Mexico, including the Gulf of California, and down through Central America to South America as far as the northern coast of Peru, as well as in eastern Pacific islands, including the Galápagos.
