

Tiny Red Skin Spots

The only known specimen of the New Ireland stingaree is a juvenile male collected by René Primevère Lesson and Prosper Garnot, during the 1822–25 expedition of the French frigate La Coquille. It was first referenced as *Urolophus armatus* by Achille Valenciennes, and furnished with a description by Johannes Müller and Jakob Henle (who are thus considered the species authorities) in their 1838–41 *Systematische Beschreibung der Plagiostomen*. Skin cancer Squamous-cell skin cancer is more likely to spread. New Ireland stingaree The International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) has listed this ray as Data Deficient, pending more information. 4 cm (6. 9 in) long, collected in the Bismarck Archipelago. Uniquely among stingarees, it has rows of sharp spinules on the posterior portion of its back and the base of its tail. Its tail is fairly long and terminates in a leaf-shaped caudal fin, and lacks a dorsal fin. This species has an oval pectoral fin disc with tiny eyes and a rectangular curtain of skin between the nostrils. Leopard complex true spots. These patterns range from progressive increases in interspersed white hair similar to graying or roan to distinctive, Dalmatian-like leopard spots on a white coat. These patterns are most closely identified with the Appaloosa and Knabstrupper breeds, though its presence in breeds from Asia to western Europe has indicated that it is due to a very ancient mutation. True leopard spots are produced only by the Lp gene, and directly reflect the underlying coat color (bay, black, gray, cremello, red dun, The leopard complex is a group of genetically related coat patterns in horses. The leopard complex gene is also linked to abnormalities in the eyes and vision. Secondary characteristics associated with the leopard complex include a white sclera around the eye, striped hooves and mottled skin

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The name "shiwaram" comes from the Shiwiar people who live in some of the same parts of the Amazon Basin as the frog. They helped herpetologists find the frog and so they could formally describe it. b8910176fb The frogs tend to have the aquatic body type if they have access to a year-round or permanent lagoon. They become littoral if they have access to only temporary bodies of water (which dry up for at least part of the year). Scientists believe this is related to the foods they eat in these two different lifestyles. b8910176fb The red-backed poison frog is a moderately toxic dendrobatid, and is the second-most poisonous of the frogs in the genus *Ranitomeya*. Its toxins are used as the frog's natural defense mechanisms, making them inedible to many, if not most, of the predators in its natural area. To advertise its poison and further reduce the risk of injury, the red-backed poison frog displays its brilliant warning colors, especially its red-orange back, for which it is named. Like all dendrobatids, it does not manufacture its poison itself, but rather is theorized to take the toxins from the ants, mites, and beetles on which it lives. The Red Indian fish was first formally described in 1844 by the Scottish naval surgeon, Arctic explorer and naturalist John Richardson with the type locality given as Southern Australia. Richardson placed his new species in a new monotypic genus, *Pataecus*. The 5th edition of *Fishes of the World* classifies the family *Pataecidae*, in which this genus is classified, within the suborder *Scorpaenoidei* which in turn is classified within the order *Scorpaeniformes*. Other authorities place the *Scorpaenoidei* within the *Perciformes*. A recent study placed the Australian prowfishes into an expanded stonefish clade, *Synanceiidae*, because all of these fish have a lachrymal sabre that can project a switch-blade-like mechanism out from underneath their eye.
