Christine Ann Denny She developed a novel technique to label neurons that encode specific memories. In a Nature paper in 2018, Denny Christine Denny is an American neuroscientist and associate professor of Clinical Neurobiology in Psychiatry in the Department of Psychiatry at Columbia University Irving Medical Center in New York City. She used this technique to probe what happens to hippocampal memory traces in different disease states. Denny investigates the molecular mechanisms underlying learning and memory. After these findings, Denny was interested in looking at the markers of stress resilience following ketamine treatment

Advances in industrial chemical processes have made it economical for pharmaceutical manufacturers to take drugs that were originally marketed as a racemic mixture and market the individual enantiomers, either by specifically manufacturing the desired enantiomer or by resolving a racemic mixture. On a case-by-case basis... Chemical/generic names are listed first, with developmental code names, synonyms, and brand names in parentheses. The list also includes non-hallucinogenic drugs related to hallucinogens, such as non-hallucinogenic serotonin 5-HT_{2A} receptor agonists and non-hallucinogenic ketamine analogues. Cannabinoids, or cannabinoid receptor modulators, are not included in this list. Many of the indications are not for continuous medication therapy but rather are for medication-assisted psychotherapy or short-term use only. The use of a drug with a single enantiomer intends to make it more effective. One enantiomer of a drug may have a desired beneficial effect while the other may cause serious and undesired side effects, or sometimes even beneficial but entirely different effects. The desired enantiomer of a given drug is known as the eutomer while the undesired enantiomer is known as the distomer. When equal amounts of both enantiomers are found in a mixture, the mixture is known as a racemic mixture. If a mixture for a drug does not have a 1:1 ratio of its enantiomers it is a candidate

Killing of Elijah McClain who was killed as a result of being illegally injected with 500 mg of ketamine by paramedics after being forcibly detained by police officers. He had been walking home from a convenience store. Both paramedics and one of the officers were convicted of negligent homicide. Three police officers and two paramedics were charged with his death. He went into cardiac arrest and died six days later in the hospital. The paramedics conviction was overturned and is pending a new trial. He went Elijah Jovan McClain (February 25, 1996 – August 30, 2019) was a 23-year-old black American man from Aurora, Colorado, who was killed as a result of being illegally injected with 500 mg of ketamine by paramedics after being forcibly detained by police officers. Ketamine-assisted psychotherapy Despite initial usage as a rapid-acting antidepressant, its hallucinogenic effects have sparked interest in its potential for treatment of mental illnesses beyond depressive symptoms. Ketamine-assisted psychotherapy shows potential in treating mental disorders including major depressive disorder, anxiety, obsessive-compulsive disorder, post-traumatic stress disorders, substance use disorder, and neuropathic pain. Unlike many other categories, such as opiates and benzodiazepines, which are established according to pharmaceutical or chemical properties, club drugs are a "category of convenience", in which drugs are included due to the locations they are consumed and/or where the user goes while under the influence of the drugs.). The term free party is used more widely in Europe than in the US. In Canada and some European countries, these events are also known as Freetekno parties. A free party might have once been described as a rave, and the origins of the two are similar. Since the birth of nightclubs in town centres in Europe the term rave had largely fallen out of fashion; however...
