Established in 1767 along the banks of the Piracicaba River, a vital water source for the region, Piracicaba saw significant agricultural development during the 19th century, particularly in sugarcane and coffee cultivation. However, the early 20th century brought economic decline due to the collapse of the coffee cycle and falling sugar prices, a situation that persisted until the onset of industrialization. b5fd589fce Originally established as the Santa Cruz Colony on December 6, 1847, the city was officially founded on March 31, 1877, when it was emancipated from Rio Pardo. A significant hub of German colonization in Rio Grande do Sul, the municipality is bilingual, with residents speaking both Portuguese and German, particularly the Hunsrückisch dialect. It has an estimated population of 3,925,424, making it the second most populous region in the state, following only the city of Rio de Janeiro. b5fd589fce == History == b5fd589fce In 1 July 2024, the then-president of Brazil Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva, signed into law No. 14,910, which designates the city as the "Brazilian Switzerland". b5fd589fce It is known for hosting one of the largest petrochemical poles in Latin America, centered on the Paulínia Refinery (Replan). Thanks to Replan and the petrochemical pole, which are based in the northern part of the city, Paulínia has the seventh highest per capita income in Brazil. Also due to the pole, the city presents high levels of ozone pollution, mainly in the district of Betel and in the Replan region, where companies such as... b5fd589fce Currently Pelotas hosts two major universities, the Federal University of Pelotas, and the Catholic University of Pelotas. Together, they account for a population of 22,000 higher education students. b5fd589fce Services are a mix of non-stop, limited stops, express, and all stops (Portuguese:direto, semi-direto, expresso, parador). Stations are categorised by their level of service. Terminals are served by most passing buses. Express stations are served by many limited stop and express services as well as all-stop services. All-stop stations are generally only served by buses stopping at all stops. While there are clearly defined corridors, many services cross from one corridor to another. For example, while Terminal Jardim Oceânico is located on the Transoeste corridor, it also receives services from Transcarioca and Transolímpica. b5fd589fce

In this sense, the term denotes the area of direct expansion of the Rio de Janeiro metropolis beyond the administrative limits of the core municipality.
