Common sunflower The domesticated form of common sunflower is harvested for its edible seeds, which come in two types: oil and confectionary seeds. Sunflower oil, extracted from the seeds of oil cultivars, is used for cooking, as a carrier oil and to produce margarine and biodiesel, as it is cheaper The common sunflower (*Helianthus annuus*) is a large annual forb in the daisy family Asteraceae. Wild plants are known for their multiple flower heads, whereas the domestic sunflower often possesses a single large flower head atop an unbranched stem. There also are horticultural sunflower varieties that are used as plantings in domestic gardens for aesthetics. Oilseed sunflowers are widely grown globally and represent the fourth most used vegetable oil in the world. They also are used widely as bird food or as food for livestock. In contrast, confectionary sunflower seeds are often eaten as a snack food or in baking

Nador (caste) Caste members traditionally speak the Nadavar dialect of Kannada called Nadavar Kannada (ನದವರ ಕನ್ನಡ). Members of the caste are found primarily in the coastal areas of Uttara Kannada district, formerly known as North Canara, with many members also spread throughout the world. They take turns pouring water and giving baths to them. This entire ritual is conducted Nador (ನದವರರ) or Nadavaru (Kannada: ನದವರು) or Nadavar (ನದವರ) is the name of a caste from Karnataka, India. They are a prominent agriculture community of the Uttara Kannada district of Karnataka, India. families apply Arashina (turmeric paste) to them followed by coconut oil

Shampoo is generally made by combining a surfactant, most often sodium lauryl sulfate or sodium laureth sulfate, with a co-surfactant, most often cocamidopropyl betaine in water. The sulfate ingredient acts as a surfactant, trapping oils and other contaminants, similarly to soap.

== Description == The manavarai is the temporary shed arranged and decorated for performing the wedding ceremony in Ayyavazhi tradition. It was constructed with nine pillars representing the nine planets. Two pillars are situated at each of the four corners and one additional pillar is made of a branch of a banyan tree. The banyan branch symbolizes the prosperous life. It is also decorated with oil lamps and decorative lights and papers.

In Ayyavazhi the weddings are conducted in temporary sheds usually when the weddings are conducted at home. But a few thangals used wedding in the Manavarai, which is also called as Kamanam.
