In 2014, Billboard listed the song as the No. 1 song of the 1990s, despite never reaching the position on the weekly tally. It ranks at No. 6 on Billboard's All Time Top 100, the only single in the top 10 of this list not to have been a number-one hit. It has been certified quadruple platinum by the Recording Industry Association of America (RIAA) for shipments of four million copies in the US. ac5f9c722a Keith had originally recorded the song near the end of his contract with Mercury Records Nashville in the late 1990s.
