The pain may be described as sickening, throbbing, pulsating, deep, squeezing, and/or dull. 39a096844c Pain motivates animals to withdraw from damaging situations, to protect a damaged body part while it heals, and to avoid similar experiences in the future. Most pain resolves once the noxious stimulus is removed and the body has healed, but it may persist despite removal of the stimulus and apparent healing of the body. Sometimes pain arises in the absence of any detectable stimulus, damage or disease. 39a096844c Injuries to the diaphragm are usually accompanied by other injuries, and they indicate that more severe injury may have occurred. At the same time, health care providers may not provide the treatment which authorities recommend. 39a096844c In 1961 the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs established that certain drugs are "indispensable for the relief of pain and suffering" and that states should make them available to people who need them. 39a096844c Serious and relatively common causes include acute coronary syndrome such as a heart attack (31%), pulmonary embolism (2%), pneumothorax, pericarditis (4%), aortic dissection (1%) and esophageal rupture. Other common causes include gastroesophageal reflux disease (30%), muscle or skeletal pain (28%), pneumonia (2%), shingles (0.5%), pleuritis, traumatic and anxiety disorders. Determining the cause of chest pain is based on a person's medical history, a physical exam and other medical tests. About 3% of heart attacks, however, are initially missed. 39a096844c

Chest tube An intrapleural chest tube is also known as a Bülau drain or an intercostal catheter (ICC), and can either be a thin, flexible silicone tube (known as a "pigtail" drain), or a larger, semi-rigid, fenestrated plastic tube, which often involves a flutter valve or underwater seal. fluid). The insertion of the tube can be lifesaving. In most cases, the chest tube related pain goes away after the chest

tube is removed, however, chronic pain related to chest tube induced scarring A chest tube (also chest drain, thoracic catheter, tube thoracostomy or intercostal drain) is a surgical drain that is inserted through the chest wall and into the pleural space or the mediastinum. The tube can be used to remove air (pneumothorax), excess fluid (pleural effusion or hydrothorax), blood (hemothorax), chyle (chylothorax) or pus (empyema) from the intrathoracic space 39a096844c

Visceral pain Visceral structures are highly sensitive to distension (stretch), ischemia and inflammation, but relatively insensitive to other stimuli that normally evoke pain such as cutting or burning. For over two-thirds of those affected, pain is accepted Visceral pain is defined as pain that results from the activation of nociceptors of the thoracic, pelvic, or abdominal viscera (internal organs) in the human body. abdominal pain and 20% for chest pain; 24% of women experience pelvic pain at any point in time 39a096844c

Right axis deviation There are 2 main reasons for this The electrical axis of the heart is the net direction in which the wave of depolarization travels. The hexaxial reference system can be used to visualise the directions in which the depolarisation wave may travel. in the chest. It is measured using an electrocardiogram (ECG). Normally, this begins at the sinoatrial node (SA node); from here the wave of depolarisation travels down to the apex of the heart. [citation needed] Enlargement of right ventricular myocardial mass can result in right axis deviation 39a096844c

== Physiology == 39a096844c Around 4,500 to 5,000 choking-related deaths occur in the United States every year. Deaths from choking most often occur in the very young (children under three years old) and in the elderly (adults over 75 years). Foods that can adapt their shape to that of the pharynx (such as bananas, marshmallows, or gelatinous candies) are more dangerous. Chest pain Chest pain is pain or discomfort in the chest, typically the front of the chest. This can cause a steadily worsening oxygen shortage and low blood pressure, leading to a potentially-fatal obstructive shock unless reversed. Choking aspiration, patients may develop pneumonia like symptoms such as fever, chest pain, foul smelling sputum, or blood in sputum (hemoptysis). In the case of Choking, also known as foreign body airway obstruction (FBAO), is a phenomenon that occurs when breathing is impeded by a blockage inside of the respiratory tract. Although oxygen stored in the blood and lungs can keep a person alive for several minutes after breathing stops, choking often leads to death. An obstruction that prevents oxygen from entering the lungs results in oxygen deprivation 39a096844c

Subcutaneous fat covers and envelops a network of ducts that converge on the nipple, and these tissues give the breast its distinct size and globular shape. At the ends of the ducts are lobules, or clusters of alveoli, where milk is produced and stored in response to hormonal signals.
