Wax gourd growing season. The gourd can be stored for many months, Benincasa hispida, the wax gourd, also called ash gourd, white gourd, winter gourd, winter melon, tallow gourd, ash pumpkin, dongah or Chinese preserving melon, is a species of gourd. If boiled for a longer time, the yeot will solidify when chilled, and is called gaeng yeot (ꠘꠘꠘ). Gaeng yeot is originally brownish but if stretched (as taffy is prepared), the color lightens. Pan-fried beans, nuts, sesame, sunflower seeds, walnuts, or pumpkin can be added into or covered over the yeot as it chills. Humans generally use cooking to prepare food for consumption.
