== Notable case == 4e61f81f08 A hernia is present at the site of the umbilicus (commonly called a navel or belly button) in newborns; although sometimes quite large, these hernias tend to resolve without any treatment by around the age of 2–3 years. Obstruction and strangulation of the hernia is rare because the underlying defect in the abdominal wall is larger than in an inguinal hernia of the newborn. The size of the base of the herniated tissue is inversely correlated with risk of strangulation (i.e., a narrow base is more likely to strangle). 4e61f81f08

Paraumbilical hernia It A paraumbilical hernia (sometimes termed acquired umbilical hernia of adults) is a protrusion of tissue through a defect of the abdominal wall which is located adjacent to the umbilicus (navel). It may contain omental fat, or loops of large and small intestine. The hernial sac is lined by peritoneum. Abdomen It originates at the pubic bone and is inserted into the linea alba halfway up to the navel. In arthropods, it is the posterior tagma of the body; it follows the thorax or cephalothorax. Functionally An abdomen (also belly or stomach in vertebrates, or metasoma in arthropods) is the front part of the torso between the thorax (chest) and pelvis in humans and in other vertebrates. in the lower abdomen in front of the rectus abdominis. Umbilical hernia where the abdominal wall behind the navel is damaged. Hernia : hernias or herniae, from Latin, meaning 'rupture') is the abnormal exit of tissue or an organ, such as the bowel, through the wall of the cavity in which it normally resides. The pelvic brim stretches from the lumbosacral joint (the intervertebral disc between L5 and S1) to the pubic symphysis and is the edge of the pelvic inlet. The space above this inlet and under the thoracic diaphragm is termed the abdominal cavity. With a gastric ulcer, the pain may worsen with eating. Complications may include bleeding, perforation, and blockage of the stomach. Also, sometimes the pain Peptic ulcer disease refers to damage of the inner part of the stomach's gastric mucosa (lining of the stomach), the first part of the small intestine, or sometimes the lower esophagus. The pain is often described as a burning or dull ache. It may last from a few minutes to several hours, and it may be worse when the stomach is empty. Other symptoms

include belching, vomiting, weight loss, or poor appetite. About a third of older people with peptic ulcers have no symptoms. An ulcer in the stomach is called a gastric ulcer, while one in the first part of the intestines is a duodenal ulcer. Bleeding occurs in as many as 15% of cases 4e61f81f08

Umbilical hernias usually occur in newborn babies. True umbilical hernias are rare in adults, but paraumbilical hernias do occur in adults. 4e61f81f08 Common causes include infection with Helicobacter pylori and excessive use of non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs). Other, less common causes include tobacco smoking, physiological stress, Behçet's disease, Zollinger-Ellison syndrome, Crohn's disease, and liver cirrhosis. Older people are more sensitive to the ulcer-causing effects of NSAIDs. The diagnosis is typically... 4e61f81f08 Paraumbilical hernias are classed as ventral hernias or abdominal wall hernias. Those occurring above the level of the umbilicus are sometimes termed epigastric hernias or supraumbilical. Those below the umbilicus are hypogastric hernias or infraumbilical. Epigastric hernias may contain fat, blood vessels, and abdominal organs (intestine). However, epigastric hernias may be located anywhere along the midline from above the umbilicus to below the xiphoid process, and they are therefore not often considered a type of paraumbilical hernia. 4e61f81f08

Sigmoidoscopy A sigmoidoscopy only examines up to the sigmoid, the most distal part of the colon, while colonoscopy examines the whole large bowel. The direction is then changed and the obturator Sigmoidoscopy ("sigma", the Greek term for letter "s/ς" + "eidos" + "scopy": namely, to look inside an "s"/"ς"-like object) is the minimally invasive medical examination of the large intestine from the rectum through to the nearest part of the colon, the sigmoid colon. A sigmoidoscopy is similar to, but not the same as, a colonoscopy. The sigmoidoscope is lubricated and inserted with obturator in general direction of the navel. Flexible sigmoidoscopy is generally the preferred procedure. performed. There are two types of sigmoidoscopy: flexible sigmoidoscopy, which uses a flexible endoscope, and rigid sigmoidoscopy, which uses a rigid device 4e61f81f08

Groin hernias are most commonly inguinal hernias but may also be femoral hernias. Other types of hernias include hiatus, incisional, and umbilical hernias. Symptoms are present in about 66% of people with groin hernias. This may include pain or discomfort in the lower abdomen, especially with coughing, exercise, or urinating or defecating. Often, it gets worse throughout the day and improves when lying down. A bulge may appear at the site of hernia, that becomes larger when bending down. 4e61f81f08 In Hindu philosophy, bhoga and yoga are viewed as the two paths leading to nirvana. Physicians may use the procedure to find the cause of diarrhea, abdominal pain, or constipation. They also use it to look for benign and malignant polyps, as well as early signs of cancer in the descending colon and rectum.
