Breastfeeding The WHO recommends then continuing breastfeeding with appropriate complementary foods for up to 2 years, and beyond. Some women report moderate to severe pain, especially women who have given birth several times, during a nursing session Breastfeeding, also known as nursing, is the process whereby breast milk is fed to an infant or toddler. Between 2015 and 2020, only about 44% of infants worldwide were exclusively breastfed in the first six months of life. The World Health Organization (WHO) recommends that breastfeeding begin within the first hour of a newborn's birth and continue as the baby wants. return to its pre-pregnancy size. Health organizations including the WHO recommend exclusively

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breastfeeding for six months; this means that no other foods or drinks—other than vitamin D supplement—are typically given. Infants may suckle directly from the breast, or milk may be extracted with a pump and then fed to the infant ab5f88ffb8

Injuries to the diaphragm are usually accompanied by other injuries, and they indicate that more severe injury may have occurred. Most often it occurs during the 3rd trimester of pregnancy and may occur before, during, or after delivery. The seizures are of the tonic-clonic type and typically last about a minute. Following the seizure, there is either a period of confusion or coma. Other complications include aspiration pneumonia, cerebral hemorrhage, kidney failure, pulmonary edema, HELLP syndrome, coagulopathy, placental abruption and cardiac arrest. ab5f88ffb8 == Classification == ab5f88ffb8 Diagnostic techniques include X-ray, computed tomography, and surgical techniques such as an explorative surgery. Diagnosis is often difficult because signs may not show up on X-ray, or signs that do show up appear similar to other conditions. Signs and symptoms include chest and abdominal pain, difficulty breathing, and decreased lung sounds.

Diaphragmatic rupture can result from blunt or penetrating trauma and occurs in about 0. 5% of all people with trauma. Pagophagia Imaging exams such as abdominal x-rays and endoscopy may be ordered Pagophagia (from Greek: pagos, frost/ice, + phagō, to eat) is the compulsive consumption of ice or

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iced drinks. or chipped teeth. Overconsumption of ice may cause bloating, gas, and stomach pain. Pica's medical definition refers to the persistent consumption of nonnutritive substances, ice in this case, for over a period of at least one month. It is a form of the disorder known as pica, which in Latin refers to a magpie that eats everything indiscriminately. However, different studies have included alternative definitions for pagophagia, including "daily consumption of 2-11 full glasses of ice (480-2640 g)" or "the purposeful ingestion of at least one ordinary tray of ice daily for a period in excess of two months. " It has been shown to be associated with iron-deficiency anemia and responsive to iron supplementation, leading some investigators to postulate that some forms of pica may be the result of nutritional deficiency

ab5f88ffb8 Vaginal birth is the most common mode of birth worldwide. It involves three stages of labour: the shortening and opening of the cervix during the first stage, descent and birth of the baby during the second, and the birth of the placenta during the third. During the first stage, contractions gradually become stronger and closer together. The postpartum period is the time of recovery for the mother and infant, in which both newborn and mother are monitored. All major health organisations advise that immediately after giving birth, regardless of the mode of birth,

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that the infant be placed on the mother's chest (termed skin-to-skin contact), and to delay any other routine procedures for at least one to two hours or until the baby has had its first breastfeeding. Low dose aspirin is recommended to prevent pre-eclampsia and eclampsia in those...

Emergency childbirth If the birth is imminent, emergency measures may be needed. Options range from delivering at home, at a hospital, a medical facility or a birthing center. Emergency services can be contacted for help in some countries. Sometimes, birth can occur on the way to these facilities, without a healthcare team. In planned childbirth, mothers choose the location and obstetric team ahead of time. for any of the following: Vaginal bleeding early or late in pregnancy Severe abdominal pain Trauma (such as a fall or car accident) while pregnant Uncontrolled Emergency childbirth is the precipitous birth of an infant in an unexpected setting. 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Corset Corsets, also known as stays, were an essential undergarment in European women's fashion from the 17th century to the early 20th century. They are traditionally constructed out of fabric with boning made of whalebone or steel, a stiff panel in the front called a busk which holds the torso rigidly upright, and some form of lacing which allows the garment to be tightened. By the beginning of the 20th century, shifting gender roles that allowed women to be more active outside the home, as well as the onsets of World War I and II (and the associated material shortages) led the corset to be largely discarded by mainstream fashion. In the 17th and 18th centuries they had a conical, straight-sided shape. 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In 2020, 1.34% of births took place outside of a hospital in California, USA, where 1 out of 8 births in the country happen. Most of the out-of-hospital births are planned, and thus, not considered an emergency childbirth. However, about 12% of attempted home deliveries need urgent transport to a hospital. A C-section typically takes between 45 minutes to an hour to complete. It may be done with a spinal block, where the woman is awake, or under general anesthesia. A urinary catheter is used to drain the bladder, and the skin of the abdomen is then cleaned with an antiseptic. An incision of about 15 cm (5.9 in) is then typically made through the mother's lower abdomen. The uterus is then opened with a second... ab5f88ffb8

Skeletal muscle cramp A lactic acid buildup around muscles can trigger cramps; however, they happen during anaerobic respiration A cramp is a sudden, involuntary, painful contraction of one or more skeletal muscles, or an overshortening of such associated with electrical activity. Cramps are common and tend to occur at rest, usually at night (nocturnal leg cramps). While generally temporary and non-damaging, they can cause significant pain and a paralysis-like immobility of the affected muscle. A cramp usually goes away on its own over several seconds or (sometimes) minutes. They are also often associated with pregnancy, physical exercise or overexertion, and age (common in older adults); in such cases, cramps are called idiopathic because there is no underlying pathology. In addition to those benign conditions, cramps are also associated with many pathological conditions. considered "normal" during

Eclampsia Pre-eclampsia is a hypertensive disorder of pregnancy that presents with three main features: new onset of high blood pressure, large amounts of protein in the urine or other organ dysfunction, and edema. The seizures of eclampsia typically present during pregnancy and before delivery Eclampsia is the onset of seizures (convulsions) in a pregnant woman with pre-eclampsia. In more severe cases, it may be fatal for both the pregnant woman and the fetus. as abdominal pain, jaundice, shortness of breath, and diminished urine output. If left untreated, pre-eclampsia can result in long-term consequences for the pregnant woman, namely increased risk of cardiovascular
