Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder When diagnosed via the ICD-10. personality disorders. ADHD is estimated to affect about 6–7% of people aged 18 and under when diagnosed via the DSM-IV criteria 05b0b20244

Historically, ADHD was not divided into presentations. Between 1987 and 1994, during the publication of the DSM-III-R, the disorder was classified as a single entity without subtypes. In the DSM-5, these subtypes were replaced with "presentations", reflecting that an individual's symptom profile can change over time. 05b0b20244

The predominantly inattentive presentation is characterized by symptoms such as difficulty sustaining attention, procrastination, hesitation in task initiation, and frequent forgetfulness. Unlike the hyperactive-impulsive and combined presentations, individuals with ADHD-PI exhibit fewer or no symptoms of hyperactivity and impulsivity. Lethargy and fatigue may be reported, but ADHD-PI is distinct from cognitive disengagement syndrome (CDS), a separate construct characterized by sluggish cognitive tempo. 05b0b20244

Adult attention deficit hyperactivity disorder Diagnosis is made clinically, via a comprehensive, structured interview whose purpose is to get full. ADHD can be diagnosed only by licensed clinicians 05b0b20244

Oppositional defiant disorder likely to be diagnosed with ODD compared to White counterparts displaying the same symptoms, who are more likely to be diagnosed with ADHD. Assessment 05b0b20244

Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder controversies The controversies involve clinicians, teachers, policymakers, parents, and the media. In China 19 percent of teachers considered ADHD to be over Diagnosed. Despite the scientifically well-established nature of attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD), its diagnosis, and its treatment, each of these has been controversial since the 1970s. Other areas of controversy include the use of stimulant medications in children, the method of diagnosis, and the possibility of overdiagnosis. Positions range from the view that ADHD is within the normal range of behavior to the hypothesis that ADHD is a genetic condition. considered ADHD to be over diagnosed while three percent considered it to be under diagnosed. In 2009, the National Institute for Health and Care Excellence, while acknowledging the controversy, stated that the current treatments and methods of diagnosis are based on the dominant view of the academic literature 05b0b20244
