Bottlenose dolphin Bottlenose dolphins can live for more than 40 years. Females typically live 5–10 years longer than males. camouflage. Older dolphins sometimes have a few spots 13687a3020

Concerns have been raised regarding the effects of anthropogenic activities on the species. Tourist vessels used for dolphin watching may disrupt normal behaviour, particularly when vessel numbers are high or when vessels approach dolphins more closely than permitted by local guidelines. 13687a3020

divided into two different species, the short-beaked common dolphin and the long-beaked common dolphin. These are now generally regarded as ecotypes. Recent research shows that many long-beaked populations worldwide are not closely related to one another, often originating from short-beaked ancestors, and they do not consistently share the same derived traits. For this reason, these forms are no longer classified as separate species. 13687a3020 The distribution of the spinner dolphin extends across the tropical and subtropical waters of all oceans. Spinner dolphins exhibit a diurnal schedule characterised by predictable daily geographic migrations, spending mornings resting and socialising in shallow coastal waters before travelling offshore to forage at night. 13687a3020

Common dolphin Common dolphins can live in aggregations or "pods" of hundreds or even thousands of dolphins. It is currently the only member of the genus *Delphinus*, the type genus of the subfamily Delphininae. as 5 °C (41 °F). Common dolphins are often seen in groups The common dolphin (*Delphinus delphis*) is the most abundant cetacean in the world, with an estimated global population of about six million. This places it as a close relative of the bottlenose dolphin, humpback dolphin, striped dolphin, spinner dolphin, Clymene dolphin, spotted dolphin, Fraser's dolphin, the tucuxi, and the Guiana dolphin 13687a3020
