In the US, biological energy is expressed using the energy unit Calorie with a capital C (i.e. a kilocalorie), which equals the energy needed to increase the temperature of 1 kilogram of water by 1 °C (about 4.18 kJ). Units of energy In slightly more fundamental terms, 1 joule is equal to 1 newton metre and, in terms of SI base units, energy is measured in large calories (a large calory is a kilocalorie, equal to 1000 calories), sometimes written capitalized as Calories. In the European Energy is defined via work, so the SI unit of energy is the same as the unit of work – the joule (J), named in honour of James Prescott Joule and his experiments on the mechanical equivalent of heat

The solar "constant" is not a physical constant in the modern CODATA scientific sense; that is, it is not like the Planck constant or the speed of light which are absolutely constant in physics. The solar constant is an average of a varying value. In the past 400 years it has varied less...

Calorimeter Reaction heats are measured and the total heat is obtained by integrating heat flow versus time. Differential scanning calorimeters, isothermal micro calorimeters, titration calorimeters and accelerated rate calorimeters are among the most common types. A simple calorimeter just consists of a thermometer attached to a metal container full of water suspended above a combustion chamber. A calorimeter is a device used for calorimetry, or the process of measuring the heat of chemical reactions or physical changes as well as heat capacity. reaction is initiated within a closed insulated container. It is one of the measurement devices used in the study of thermodynamics, chemistry, and biochemistry

Biomass can be measured by a bomb calorimeter.

Food energy This is usually measured in calories or joules. Solar output The solar constant (denoted as $S_{\odot}$ by the IAU standard) is a mathematical equation averaging the amount of energy received by a given area one astronomical unit away from the Sun. It is measured on a surface perpendicular to the rays, one astronomical unit (au) from the Sun (roughly the distance from the Sun to the Earth). which is 81

A pyramid of energy shows how much energy is retained in the form of new biomass from each trophic level, while a pyramid of biomass shows how much biomass (the amount of living or organic matter present in an organism) is present in the organisms. There is also a pyramid of numbers representing the number of individual organisms at each trophic level. Pyramids of energy are normally upright, but other pyramids can be inverted (pyramid of biomass for marine region) or take other shapes (spindle shaped pyramid). == History == The solar constant includes radiation over the entire electromagnetic spectrum. It is measured by satellite as being 1.361 kilowatts per square meter (kW/m²) at solar minimum (the time in the 11-year solar cycle when the number of sunspots is minimal) and approximately 0.1% greater (roughly 1.362 kW/m²) at solar maximum. == History ==

Energy homeostasis Fifty percent of the energy from glucose metabolism is immediately converted to heat. related compounds, or dissipated as heat. Energy intake is modulated In biology, energy homeostasis, or the homeostatic control of energy balance, is a biological process that involves the coordinated homeostatic regulation of food intake (energy inflow) and energy expenditure (energy outflow). The human brain, particularly the hypothalamus, plays a central role in regulating energy homeostasis and generating the sense of hunger by integrating a number of biochemical signals that transmit information about energy balance. Energy intake is measured by the amount of calories consumed from food and fluids

The law claims that the basis of nutrition is the exchange of energy. In the early 1900s, Carl von Noorden applied isodynamic law to the study of obesity and developed two theories on what caused people to develop obesity. The first repeated Rubner's notion that "a calorie is a calorie". The second claimed that obesity is a consequence of how the body partitions calories for use or storage.
