

Is Lettuce Good For Health

In 2008, public sales of çiğ köfte with raw meat were banned by the Health Ministry of Turkey due to health hazards, especially taeniasis, thus leaving only plant-based versions in shops and restaurants.

Cantonese cuisine and through the Chinese diaspora, was introduced to other countries such as the United States and Australia around the mid-to-late 20th century, where it became part of Westernized adaptations of Chinese cuisine.
