Chaffing and winnowing The chaff and Chaffing and winnowing is a cryptographic technique to achieve confidentiality without using encryption when sending data over an insecure channel. The name is derived from agriculture: after grain has been harvested and threshed, it remains mixed together with inedible fibrous chaff. The cryptographic technique was conceived by Ron Rivest and published in an on-line article on 18 March 1998. The bacteria thrives in moist environments, and produces a cream to yellow bacterial ooze, which, when dry, appears light colored and scale-like, resulting in a streak on the leaves. *undulosa*. Chaff was established by the Massey Agricultural College Students' Association. After Massey gained university status in 1964, Chaff became the newspaper of the Massey University Students' Association. After the university established new campuses in Albany and Wellington in the 1990s, Chaff remained the newspaper of students on the original Manawātū campus in Palmerston North, while new publications were established for the new campuses. The newspaper ceased publication after the New Zealand Parliament passed a law making membership of student associations voluntary, which made them more dependent on funding from their universities, although it had been losing money and was considering cutbacks before this. In 2012, a university-wide student publication, Massive, was launched, replacing Chaff, Wellington's Magneto and Albany's Satellite. eb0378e546

Wheat flour Soft flour is comparatively low in gluten and thus results in a loaf with a finer, crumbly texture. Soft flour, in the US, is usually divided into cake flour, which is the lowest in gluten, and pastry flour, which has slightly more gluten than cake flour. Hard flour, or bread flour, is high in gluten, with 12% to 14% gluten content, and its dough has elastic toughness that holds its shape well once baked.
