Fecal-oral route If soil or water bodies are polluted with fecal material, humans can be infected with waterborne diseases or soil-transmitted diseases. F-diagram can be used to show how proper sanitation (in particular toilets, hygiene, handwashing) can act as an effective barrier to stop transmission of diseases The fecal-oral route (also called the oral-fecal route or orofecal route) describes a particular route of transmission of a disease wherein pathogens in fecal particles pass from one person to the mouth of another person. Fecal contamination of food is another form of fecal-oral transmission. Toilet flushing and subsequent inhaled aerosols is another potential route. Washing hands properly after changing a baby's diaper or after performing anal hygiene can prevent foodborne illness from spreading. Main causes of fecal-oral disease transmission include lack of adequate sanitation (leading to open defecation), and poor hygiene practices 6e0d88ba56

Permanent water chlorination began in 1905, when a faulty slow sand filter and a contaminated water supply caused a serious typhoid fever epidemic in Lincoln, England. Alexander Cruickshank Houston used chlorination of the water to stop the epidemic. His installation fed a concentrated solution of so-called "chlorinated lime" (a mixture of calcium hypochlorite, calcium hydroxide and calcium chloride) to the water being treated. This was not simply... 6e0d88ba56 The common factors in the fecal-oral route can be summarized as five Fs: fingers, flies, fields, fluids, and food. Diseases caused by fecal-oral transmission include typhoid, cholera, polio, hepatitis and many other infections, especially ones that cause diarrhea. 6e0d88ba56 Bacteria are responsible for more than half of cases, typically via foodborne illness and waterborne diseases. The bacteria enterotoxigenic Escherichia coli (ETEC) are typically the most common except in Southeast Asia, where Campylobacter is more prominent. About 10 to 20 percent of cases are due to norovirus. Protozoa such as Giardia may cause longer-term disease.

The risk is greatest in the first two weeks of travel and among young adults. People affected are more often from the developed world.

Early attempts at implementing water chlorination at a water treatment plant were made in 1893 in Hamburg, Germany.
