UV radiation is present in sunlight and constitutes about 10% of the total electromagnetic radiation output from the Sun. Wavelengths between 10 and 100 nanometers are called extreme ultraviolet and share some properties with soft X-rays. UVB radiation can cause direct DNA Ultraviolet radiation (UV; sometimes called ultraviolet light) is electromagnetic radiation of wavelengths of 100–400 nanometers, shorter than that of visible light, but longer than X-rays 5fdb8264b

The photons of ultraviolet have greater energy than those of visible light, from about 3.1 to 12 electron volts, around the minimum energy required to ionize atoms. Although long-wavelength ultraviolet is not considered an ionizing radiation because its photons lack sufficient energy, it can induce chemical reactions and cause many substances to glow or fluoresce. Many practical applications, including chemical and biological effects, are derived from the way that UV radiation can interact with organic molecules. These interactions can involve exciting orbital electrons to higher energy states in molecules potentially breaking... 5fdb8264b What became BB cream was originally formulated in the 1960s in Germany by dermatologist Dr. Christine Schrammek to protect her patients' skin after facial peels and surgery. Toners were developed as a solution aimed at restoring the skin's natural acidity.
