The season marked the first time that four Ivy League teams (Harvard, Penn, Princeton and Yale) participated in the postseason. Harvard was the preseason favorite for the first time and spent most of the season receiving vote in the 2011–12 national rankings. The university comprises eleven schools and enrolls nearly 13,800 students from the US and 70 foreign countries. Vanderbilt is classified among "R1: Doctoral Universities – Very high research activity". Several research centers and institutes are affiliated with the university, including the Robert Penn Warren Center for the Humanities, the Freedom Forum First Amendment Center, and Dyer Observatory. Vanderbilt University Medical Center, formerly part of the university, became a separate institution in 2016.
