Malabathrum In the language of Kerala, Malayalam, the plant is called vazhana. The name malabathrum is used in mediaeval Malabathrum, malabathron, or malobathrum is the name used in classical and medieval texts for certain cinnamon-like aromatic plant leaves and an ointment prepared from those leaves. It is also known as edana in Malayalam. Silver pomfrets are usually silver/white in color, with few small scales. They can grow up to a range of 4–6 kg (8–13 lb). However, due to overfishing, specimens weighing less than 1 kg (2 lb) are more commonly seen. Having originated in South India, the weapon's earliest name-form was likely the Tamil kaṭṭāri (காட்டாரி). It is alternatively known in Tamil as kuttuvāl (குத்துவால்) which means "stabbing blade". This was adapted into Sanskrit as kaṭār (काटार) or kaṭārī. The name however is of Indo-Aryan origin, which means Tamil loaned the word from them. Malabathrum is mentioned in the first century Greek text Periplus Maris Erythraei and sourced to a people called 'Sêsatai', identified with Kirradai (Kirata) of Ptolemy. Though malabathrum was a product of Northeast India, it was rarely traded by the western traders at the mouth of the Ganges (which is much closer to the source) but at southwestern Indian ports of Muziris/Nelcynda. It is mentioned in the Periplus that some people collected the green leaves after the Sêsatai in the northeast prepared them and carried them to the ports of trade.
