There are four main types of sentence: discharges, fines, community sentences and custodial (or prison) sentences. If a court convicts a defendant but decides not to impose any punishment, they are discharged conditionally or absolutely. Discharges may be ordered for any offence where the penalty is not fixed by law, although in practice they are used in the least serious offences. Fines are the most common sentence. 89222dd017

Research shows the discretion of sentencing is effectively shifted to prosecutors, as they decide what charges to bring against a defendant. using a gun during a crime, 20 years; imprisonment for firing a gun during a crime, and 25 years; imprisonment in addition to any other sentence for shooting Mandatory sentencing requires that people convicted of certain crimes serve a predefined term of imprisonment, removing the discretion of judges to take issues such as extenuating circumstances and a person's likelihood of rehabilitation into consideration when sentencing. Mandatory sentencing laws vary across nations; civil law jurisdictions usually prescribe minimum and maximum sentences for every type of crime in explicit laws. The maximum determinate sentence is a life sentence with a 25-year parole ineligibility period. For offences committed prior to 2 December 2011 all life sentences and related parole ineligibility periods are served concurrently (at the same time). In cases of multiple murder, where the offence occurred after 2 December 2011 (the date new legislation came into force), a court may, after considering any jury recommendation, order consecutive parole ineligibility periods for each murder.
