As opportunistic feeders, they will also take advantage of edible aquatic plants as well as any fruits, nuts or seeds that may fall into the waters. They are not a migratory species but do travel to seek out conditions conducive to breeding and spawning during periods of increased rainfall. Red-bellied piranhas often travel in shoals as a predatory defense but rarely exhibit group hunting behavior. Omnivores come from diverse backgrounds that often independently evolved sophisticated consumption capabilities. For instance, dogs evolved from primarily carnivorous organisms (Carnivora) while pigs evolved from primarily herbivorous organisms (Artiodactyla). Despite this, physical characteristics such as tooth morphology may be reliable indicators of diet in mammals, with such morphological adaptation having been observed in bears.

The name originates from Old Tupi *pirãia*, from Proto-Tupi-Guarani **pirãj*, being first attested in *Vocabulário da Língua Brasileira*, a 1585 Portuguese-Tupi bilingual dictionary, as a translation for scissors. The first description and attribution of this name to the fish would occur two years later, in the 1587 treatise *Notícia do Brasil* by Portuguese explorer Gabriel Soares de Sousa.

Serrasalminids are medium- to large-sized characiform bony fishes that reach about 1 m (3.3 ft) long, generally characterized by a deep, laterally compressed body with a series of midventral abdominal spines or scutes, and a long dorsal fin (over 16 rays). Most species also possess an anteriorly directed spine just before the dorsal fin extending from a supraneural bone; exceptions include members of the genera *Colossoma*, *Piaractus*, and *Mylossoma*.

Etymology

Piranha first appears in 1710 in English literature, borrowed from Portuguese. Alternative spellings include the Spanish-derived *piraña*, as well as the archaic *piraya*.

Brown in color and covered with dark blotches, males grow to a total length (including tail) of 2–3 m (6 ft 7 in – 9 ft 10 in) and weigh around 40–50 kg (88–110 lb); while females grow to 1.4 m (4 ft 7 in) long and about 15–20 kg (33–44 lb). Typical habitats of this caiman include lakes, rivers, and wetlands. Mating occurs in the rainy season and eggs

hatch in March, with young fending for themselves as soon as they hatch. Its diet primarily consists of aquatic animals, such as snails, and occasionally land vertebrates.
