Solar viewer Solar viewers Solar viewers (also known as solar viewing glasses or solar eclipse glasses) are special eyewear designed for direct viewing of the Sun. Solar viewers can be used for safe viewing of solar events such as eclipses. In addition to blocking visible light, solar viewers also block ultraviolet and infrared rays which can damage one's eyes. The recommended

optical density of this eyewear is 5, meaning that the solar viewing filter only permits 1 part in 100,000 of incident light to pass through. Standard sunglasses are unable to filter out eye-damaging radiation. products manufactured to meet the standards of ISO 12312-2 can be used indefinitely as long as they have not been damaged by scratches or tears f305d01b52
