Arturo Álvarez-Buylla Godino, the High Commissioner of Spain in Morocco, had refused to join the rebellion but was eventually captured and replaced by Colonel Eduardo Sáenz de Buruaga. By then, the rebels had seized control of the Protectorate. Spanish prime minister Santiago Casares Quiroga, who received reports of the events in Morocco in the evening of 17 July, ordered the Spanish Navy and the Air Force to strike the main rebel strongholds. The loyal military improvised Douglas DC-2 and Fokker F VII transport planes to bomb military headquarters and airfields at Melilla, Ceuta, Larache and Tétouan. aa2e4f5e99

Uncle Charles Principle Joyce uses the "Uncle Charles Principle" to represent two roles in the novel, that of its protagonist, Leopold Bloom, and that of the classic literary narrator. Joyce acknowledged having been inspired by the work Les Lauriers Sont Coupés by the French writer Édouard Dujardin. In his study Joyce's Voices, Kenner analyzes in depth the use of this technique throughout the novel Ulysses. and Juan Rulfo. The procedure, however, receives its name from a character in another of Joyce's novels: A Portrait of the Artist as a Young Man. The Muisca ate a variety of roots and tubers and even had a specific word in their Chibcha language for eating those: bgysqua. The network was composed of formal roads carefully planned, engineered, built, marked and maintained; paved where necessary, with stairways to gain elevation, bridges and accessory constructions such as retaining walls, and water drainage systems.
