Some of those side effects can persist long Isotretinoin, also known as 13-cis-retinoic acid and sold under the brand name Accutane among others, is a medication used to treat skin diseases like harlequin-type ichthyosis, lamellar

ichthyosis, and severe cystic acne or moderate acne that is unresponsive to antibiotics. In its pure form, isotretinoin is an orange powder. Its isomer, tretinoin, is also an acne drug. It is a retinoid, meaning it is related to vitamin A, and is found in small quantities naturally in the body 2940b1fe18

The most common adverse effects are dry lips (cheilitis), dry and fragile skin (xeroderma), dry eyes and an increased susceptibility to sunburn. Uncommon and rare side effects include muscle aches and pains (myalgias), headaches, and depression in some users.
