COVID-19 pandemic in Portugal On 2 March 2020, the virus was confirmed to have reached the country when it was reported that two men, a 60-year-old doctor who travelled to Northern Italy on vacation and a 33-year-old man working in Spain, tested positive for COVID-19. On 16 March 2020, the first death from COVID-19 was reported in Portugal. The following measures were adopted: Mandatory domiciliary or hospital confinement for people infected with COVID-19 or subject to active health The COVID-19 pandemic in Portugal was a part of the pandemic of coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2). winter 725858d589

Healthcare in Portugal The Health Regulatory Entity (ERS) is the public independent entity responsible for the regulation of the activity of all the public, private and social healthcare providers. In addition, about 25% of the population is covered by the health subsystems, 10% by private insurance schemes and another 7% by mutual funds. several hospital units located in the same city or region. In 2019 the government proposes to scrap all fees, which constitute about 2 percent of the SNS's budget, apart from some hospital emergencies. The Ministry of Health is responsible for developing health policy as well as managing the SNS. Independent hospitals and hospital centers are classified as group I (general hospitals), II (district Healthcare in Portugal is provided through three coexisting systems: the National Health Service (Portuguese: Serviço Nacional de Saúde, SNS), special social health insurance schemes for certain professions (health subsystems) and voluntary private health insurance. The SNS provides universal coverage, although in 2012 measures were implemented to ensure the sustainability of the service by the introduction of user fees to be paid for at the end of treatments 725858d589
