Changing any of these factors can increase the size of the economy. However, GDP is not a measure of overall standard of living or well-being, as it does not account for how income is distributed among the population. Dividing total GDP by the population gives an idealized rough measure of GDP per capita. GDP is often used to measure the economic activity of a country or region. Several national and international economic organizations, such as Gross domestic product (GDP) is a monetary measure of the total market value of all of the final goods and services which are produced and rendered during a specific period of time (usually a year) by a country or countries. A country may rank high in GDP but still experience jobless growth depending on its planned economic structure and strategies. For example, population growth through mass immigration can raise consumption and demand for public services, thereby contributing to GDP growth. The major components of GDP are consumption, government spending, net exports (exports minus imports), and investment.
