EMI briefly considered "Too Dizzy" for release as a fourth Never Let Me Down is the seventeenth studio album by the English musician David Bowie, released on 21 April 1987 through EMI America Records. Bowie's goal for the project was to record it differently following his disappointment with 1984's Tonight. Musically, Never Let Me Down has been characterised as pop rock, art rock and hard rock; Bowie himself considered the record a return to rock and roll music

It is mostly self-produced by JPEGMafia, with involvement from other producers such as Flume and Kenny Beats on several tracks. Themed on capitalism, conscription, the war on drugs, patriotism, and politics, the album emphasizes a boastful nature and an eclectic use of sampling. It later evolves towards introspection and vulnerability by third of the album, focusing on JPEGMafia's career, depression, romantic flaws, past struggles, and traumatic experiences. The BBC transmitted new installments of the programme weekly from January 1964 through July 2006, and later converted it into a radio programme. Deuce (musician) Deuce has also collaborated with artists NXTREADY, Ronnie Radke, Brokencyde and Blood on the Dance Floor. Brought to fame as a member of the rap rock band Hollywood Undead, Deuce departed from Hollywood Undead in 2010 and has since moved on to solo work through the label "Five Seven Music", a branch of Eleven Seven Music.
