The tales of Song Jiang and his band were popular among the literati as well as with unlettered audiences from the Song onward. Zalul Environmental Association Zalul seeks to put a stop to the spillage of sewage and other toxic waste into Israel's rivers through legal and legislative reforms. "Don't Say Kaddish for the Lachish" is Zalul's slogan for a campaign to save the Lachish River, which runs between the cities of Ashkelon and Lachish. Zalul Environmental Association (Or in short "Zalul", צלול, lit:clear) is an Israeli environmental group founded in 1999 with the goal protecting the seas and rivers of Israel through conservation, activism, research, awareness-raising and education.

== Projects and campaigns == Large-scale demonstrations have been held protesting the pollution of the Kishon. Zalul's report has prompted the Ministry of the Environment to investigate the problem and introduce clean-up measures. 2023: Accelerating Change Song Jiang is mentioned in the "Thirty-six eulogies for Song Jiang and his group, with preface" and *History of Song*, the most authoritative records on the history of the Song dynasty. It was once the sixth-largest saltwater lake on Earth, with a surface area of approximately 6,000 km² (2,300 sq mi), a length of 140 km (87 mi), a width of 70 km (43 mi), and a maximum depth of 20 m (66 ft)

By late 2017, the lake had shrunk to 10% of its former size (and 1/60 of water volume in 1998) due to persistent general drought in Iran, but also the damming of the rivers that flow into it, and the pumping of groundwater from the surrounding area. This dry spell was broken in 2019 and the lake began filling up once again, due to both increased rain and water diversion from the Zab River under the Urmia Lake Research Programme. The trend reversed again in early 2020s, and a combination of drought and administrative mismanagement caused a renewed acute drop in water levels. Based on NASA's satellite imagery, the lake had almost entirely dried up by September 2025. Couney is best-known for his Infantorium at Coney Island, New York. During Couney's active years at fairgrounds across America, it was widely believed that premature babies were "weaklings", who were unfit to survive into adulthood. Couney was one of the first advocates for premature babies, and his Infantoriums have become widely accredited with saving the lives of over 6,500 premature babies. Couney is additionally recognised as one of the first pioneers of neonatological technology.

Martin A. Couney 1900s was even tagged "Kill Defectives, Save the Nation" and articles in medical journals questioned efforts to save premature infants, doubting the efficacy Martin Arthur Couney (born Michael Cohen, 1869 – March 1, 1950) was an American obstetrician of German-Jewish descent, an advocate and pioneer of early neonatal technology. Couney, also known as 'the Incubator Doctor', was
