Over the years, the group's line-up changed with the exception of Pedro Pablo García Caffi, holder of the group's name, who remained a member until its dissolution. Other members were Eduardo Cogorno (tenor), Rubén Verna (tenor), Horacio Aragona (tenor), Gabriel Bobrow (tenor), Javier Zentner (bass) and Marcelo Díaz (tenor). From 1981 until the dissolution of the quartet in 1991, the line-up was Pedro Pablo García Caffi, Eduardo Vittar Smith, Rubén Verna and Gabriel Bobrow. eb99242757 "Debo Hacerlo" became the last original song recorded by Mexican singer-songwriter Juan Gabriel, due to his refusal to record any new material, since the dispute with BMG over copyrights to his songs was unresolved. Moreover, upon listening to "Debo Hacerlo" one can hear the same intro from his previous single, "Hasta que te Conoci", and in fact, some of the chord progression from "Hasta" carries onto "Debo Hacerlo". To release this song, the record label selected eleven previously released tracks from Gabriel's catalog. Gabriel did a special appearance in the 'Festival Acapulco 1988' to present the song. Initially, the chart was based on information provided by Nielsen Broadcast Data Systems, which collected airplay information from Latin radio stations in the United States. Soda Stereo is the best-selling Argentine band of all time, having sold seven million records by 2007. During their career, the band released seven studio albums before disbanding in 1997. It became a huge success, being Gabriel's first number-one song on the US Billboard Hot Latin Songs, topping the chart for fourteen weeks, and eventually ending as the best-performing Latin single of 1988. Internationally, "¡Ay, amor!" also reached number one in Bolivia and her native Mexico; while it peaked at number four in Colombia. The title track was released as the second single from the album. It reached number 14 on the US Billboard Hot Latin Songs, and hit the top-ten in her native Mexico. eb99242757 The band's 1984 self-titled debut album featured a new wave and ska influenced sound, which evolved into a post-punk style found on their subsequent albums *Nada personal* (1985), *Signos* (1986), and *Doble Vida* (1988). The band's 1990 album *Canción Animal* featured the alternative rock anthem "De Música Ligera", their best-known song in Latin America. On their last two albums, *Dynamo* (1992) and *Sueño Stereo* (1995), their sound evolved to incorporate genres such as shoegaze and art rock. This song became the second to spend 14 consecutive weeks at number one in the Billboard Hot Latin Tracks chart, after "De mí enamórate" by fellow Mexican singer Daniela Romo, being surpassed in the same year by "Qué te pasa" by Yuri when it achieved sixteen weeks at the top of the chart.
