Heating the water before adding the sugar allows more sugar to dissolve thus producing larger crystals. Crystals form after six to seven days. == Etymology == 845cca4948 To prepare it, dhal (mung bean or moong dal) is roasted in a karahi/kadai in coconut or sesame oil. This is then cooled and crushed into a fine powder. Sesame seeds and coconut flakes are similarly and separately roasted and powdered. These powders are then combined with cardamom and jaggery syrup. Ragi mudde has only two ingredients: ragi (finger millet) flour, and water. A tablespoon of ragi flour is first mixed with water to make a very thin paste and later added to a thick-bottomed vessel containing water on a stove top. As this mixture boils and reaches the brim of the vessel, ragi flour is added, which forms a mound on top of boiling water. Once the ragi flour is added, it requires immediate mixing (to avoid lumps) with the help of a wooden stick (Kannada: ಕುಳಿ ಕಟ್ಟು: mudde kolu/Kannada... 845cca4948
