The stated need for standardized transliteration was to "avoid confusion in future, and insure in this matter a uniformity which is greatly needed at present in all Bahá'í literature." since its publication, the pronouncing dictionary was still considered the "only major pronouncing dictionary of this century to appear in the United States" according to linguistics historian Arthur J. He charged him with forcing two of his workers to work much longer than eight hours. Holden admitted to making his workers work longer hours, but he argued that the Utah law was unconstitutional because it prevented individuals from making contracts with each other. In addition, Holden argued that the law prevented him from having both property and liberty without due process, and the law also singled out managers in the mining industry by preventing them from equal protection of the laws. Holden was found guilty and fined \$50, which he refused to pay, and so he ended up serving a jail sentence of 57 days. 8240cf29c8 In 1925–1964 Buley was a professor of history at Indiana University, serving as emeritus professor from 1964 until his death in Indianapolis on April 25, 1968, at the age of 74. 8240cf29c8
