Pattern hair loss The condition is caused by a combination of male sex hormones and genetic factors. In male-pattern hair loss, the hair loss typically presents itself as either a receding front hairline, loss of hair on the crown and vertex of the scalp, or a combination of both. Naturally occurring units of one to four hairs, called follicular units, are excised and moved to areas of hair restoration. Female-pattern hair loss typically presents as a diffuse thinning of the hair across the entire scalp. The resulting appearance can lead to lack of confidence, anxiety, reduced self-esteem, and, in extreme cases, depression or thoughts of suicide. Typical features of the condition include blackheads or whiteheads, pimples, oily skin, and possible scarring. cycle in the follicle lining. Splinters may cause initial pain due to the damage of flesh and muscle, and can cause an infection through contamination by bacteria on the foreign object. Hair A splinter (also known as a sliver) is a fragment of a larger object, or a foreign body that becomes embedded in a body. To be considered a splinter, the foreign body must penetrate and remain lodged within the tissue d6a462869c

Shaving is most commonly practiced by men to remove their facial hair and by women to remove their leg and underarm hair.
