Modern Western height discrimination originated in 19th century eugenic, Social Darwinist, and white supremacist movements, beginning with eugenicist Sir Francis Galton's observation of the correlation of human height between parents and offspring. These movements popularized pseudoscientific beliefs about the superiority of larger male stature, embodied by the Nazi height ideals within the social construct of the Aryan master race. e30f49d429 is defined traditionally as the mean wave height (trough to crest) of the highest

It is usually defined as four times the standard deviation of the surface elevation – or equivalently as four times the square root of the zeroth-order moment (area) of the wave spectrum. The symbol H_m0 is usually used for that latter definition. The significant wave height (H_s) may thus refer to H_m0 or $H/3$; the difference in magnitude between the two definitions is only a few percent. Height is also important because it is closely correlated with other health components, such as life expectancy. Studies show that there is a correlation between small stature and a longer life expectancy. Individuals of small stature are also more likely to have lower blood pressure and are less likely to acquire cancer. The University of Hawaii has found that the "longevity gene" FOXO3 that reduces the effects of aging is more commonly found in individuals of small body size. Short stature decreases the risk of venous insufficiency.
