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Nematode infection in dogs For most nematodes, an infection can be detected by examining the feces for eggs or larvae. The infection therefore does not necessarily have to manifest itself in a worm disease (helminthosis). unborn puppies. Nematodes, as so-called endoparasites ("internal parasites"), colonize various internal organs - most of them the digestive tract - and the

skin. However, the majority of them often cause no or only minor symptoms of disease in adult animals. Roundworm infection in dogs and the hookworm in dogs is of particular health significance in Central Europe, as they can also be transmitted to humans (zoonosis). To date, about 30 different species of nematode have been identified in domestic dogs; they are essentially also found in wild dog species. Regular deworming can significantly reduce the frequency of infection and thus the risk of infection for humans and dogs
