In 1923 the orebody containing lead, zinc and silver was discovered by the miner John Campbell Miles. Prominent mining engineer William Henry Corbould was invited to the field by Douglas MacGilvray, who held options over several tenements, and immediately noted similarities between the Mount Isa orebodies and those of Broken Hill, New South Wales. Corbould secured an option over 400 acres (160 ha) and in January 1924 floated Mount Isa Mines Ltd (MIM) in Sydney with himself as director and general manager. e67c4dc149

One important use of the technology was to receive medical advice or summon a doctor by contacting the Royal Flying Doctor Service.
