Palms have large The **Areaceae** () are a family of perennial, flowering plants in the monocot order **Arecales**. Currently, 181 genera with around 2,600 species are known, most of which are restricted to tropical and subtropical climates. Several palm genera have both solitary and clustering members. However, palms exhibit an enormous diversity in physical characteristics and inhabit nearly every type of habitat within their range, from rainforests to deserts. Their growth form can be climbers, shrubs, tree-like and stemless plants, all commonly known as palms. Palms which are usually solitary may grow in clusters and vice versa. Those having a tree-like form are colloquially called palm trees

Most Phoenix species originate in semi-arid regions, but usually occur near high groundwater levels, rivers, or springs. The diverse habitats they occupy include swamps, deserts, and mangrove sea coasts. The genus is unusual among members of subfamily Coryphoideae in having pinnate, rather than palmate leaves; tribe Caryoteae also have pinnate or bipinnate leaves. frequently hybridise where they grow in proximity. Date palms reach up to 30 metres (98 ft) in height, growing singly or in clumps with several stems from a single root system. Slow-growing, they can reach over 100 years of age when maintained properly. Their born fruit (dates) are oval-cylindrical, 3 to 7 centimetres (1 to 3 inches) long, and about 2.5 cm (1 in) in diameter, with colour ranging from dark brown to bright red or yellow, depending on variety. Containing 63–64% sugar by mass when dried, dates are consumed as sweet snacks on their own or with confections. 666917b1ae

List of hardy palms Despite the fact that this palm is less hardy Hardy palms are any of the species of palm (Arecaceae) that are able to withstand brief periods of colder temperatures and even occasional snowfall. A few palms are native to higher elevations of South Asia where true winter conditions occur, while a few others are native to the warmer parts of the temperate zone in southern Europe, and others are native throughout temperate and subtropical locales in the Americas and Oceania. the Cretan date palm, it is very drought-tolerant and hardy to -12°C (10°F), but does prefer hot summers. Many of these "hardy" species can be cultivated in warmer parts of temperate and subtropical climates. A few of these temperate climate palms can tolerate hard freezes with little or no damage 666917b1ae
