Software development – development of a software product, which entails computer programming (process of writing and maintaining the source code), and encompasses a planned and structured process from the conception of the desired software to its final manifestation. Therefore, software development may include research, new development, prototyping, modification, reuse, re-engineering, maintenance, or any other activities that result in software products. af117616a7 Scrum prescribes for teams to break work into goals to be completed within time-boxed iterations, called sprints.

Each sprint is no longer than one month and commonly lasts two weeks. The scrum team assesses progress in time-boxed, stand-up meetings of up to 15 minutes, called daily scrums. At the end of the sprint, the team holds two further meetings: one sprint review to demonstrate the work for stakeholders and solicit feedback, and one internal sprint retrospective. While training and development technically have differing definitions, the terms are often used interchangeably. Charles B. Myers and Lynn K. Myers used the phrase professional learning community in relation to schools in their 1995 book *The Professional Educator: A New Introduction to Teaching and Schools*, and a year later Charles B. Myers presented a paper at the annual meeting of the American Educational Research Association titled "Beyond the PDS: Schools as Professional Learning Communities" that proposed a path from professional development school (PDS) efforts to schools as professional learning communities. In 1997, Shirley M.
