Pop-Tarts The pastry consists of a sweet filling sealed inside two layers of thin, rectangular pastry crust. Although sold precooked, they are designed to be warmed inside a toaster or microwave oven. They are usually sold in pairs inside Mylar packages and do not require refrigeration. They were brought back in a larger size in 2018, as Pop Tart Crisps Pop-Tarts (stylized as pop•tarts) is an American brand of toaster pastries produced and distributed by Kellanova (formerly Kellogg's) since 1964.
