The three types of ADHD are: inattentive (ADHD-I), hyperactive (ADHD-HI), and combination (ADHD-C). Of the types, the most common was inattentive followed by hyperactive and then finally combination. Adult attention deficit hyperactivity disorder Approximately two-thirds of children with ADHD continue to experience impairing symptoms into adulthood, with symptoms ranging from minor inconveniences to impairments in daily functioning, and up to one-third continue to meet the full diagnostic criteria. This represents a change from the DSM-IV, which required symptom onset before the age of 7. Adult attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (adult ADHD) is ADHD that persists into adulthood. It is a neurodevelopmental disorder, meaning impairing symptoms must have been present in childhood, except for when ADHD occurs after traumatic brain injury. Management of Tourette syndrome The management of Tourette syndrome has the goal of managing symptoms to achieve optimum functioning, rather than eliminating symptoms; not all persons with Tourette's require treatment, and there is no cure or universally effective medication. Explanation and reassurance alone are often sufficient treatment; education is an important part of any treatment plan. Common side effects include dry mouth, dizziness, headaches, hypotension, and sleepiness. Severe side effects may include hallucinations, heart arrhythmias, and confusion. If rapidly stopped,

withdrawal effects may occur, such as a dangerous rise in blood pressure. Use during pregnancy or breastfeeding is not recommended. Clonidine lowers blood pressure by stimulating α 2-adrenergic receptors and imidazoline receptors in the brain, which results in relaxation of many arteries. 6de17bdb70

In 2009, the National Institute for Health and Care Excellence, while acknowledging the controversy, stated that the current treatments and methods of diagnosis are based on the dominant view of the academic literature. Positions range from the view that ADHD is within the normal range of behavior to the hypothesis that ADHD is a genetic condition. The controversies involve clinicians, teachers, policymakers, parents, and the media. Other areas of controversy include the use of stimulant medications in children, the method of diagnosis, and the possibility of overdiagnosis 6de17bdb70

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
