== Location == 0577af13ef The mediastinum has three main parts: the anterior mediastinum (front), the middle mediastinum, and the posterior mediastinum (back). Tumors in the anterior portion of the mediastinum can include thymoma, lymphoma, germ cell tumors including teratoma, thyroid tissue, and parathyroid lesions. Masses in this area are more likely to be malignant than those in other compartments. Middle mediastinal tumors are less common and refer to cardiac or neurogenic tumors. Masses in the posterior portion of the mediastinum tend to be neurogenic in origin, and in adults tend to be of neural sheath origin including shwannomas and neurofibromas. 0577af13ef

Mediastinal tumors Teratomas A mediastinal tumor is a tumor in the mediastinum, the cavity that separates the lungs from the rest of the chest. It contains the heart, esophagus, trachea, thymus, and aorta. as yolk sac tumors or embryonal carcinomas. It extends from the sternum to the spinal column. Benign teratomas are the most common subtype and may contain tissue such as hair, teeth and bone 0577af13ef

Residing on the long-arm of chromosome 3, the Tumor Protein 63 (TP63) gene is critical for proper development and homeostasis of stratified epithelia. In Hay-Wells syndrome, and other ectodermal dysplasia disorders, a missense, nonsense, or insertion mutation has occurred in

A "false" mixed tumor contains one type of neoplastic cells, but which have more than one appearance. For example, benign pleomorphic salivary gland tumors may have some tumors cells that form pseudocartilage. Yet, all the tumor cells have similar myoepithelial profile on immunohistochemistry, and are thus classified as one cell type. 0577af13ef Loose anagen syndrome is primarily described in fair-haired children who have easily dislodgeable hair. It is commonly present in younger children, generally between the ages of 2 and 8. It is especially observed in female children with light coloured hair. Females and males have differences in hair. There are knowledge gaps about loose anagen syndrome in males, and a 6 to 1 incidence ratio of females to males with loose anagen syndrome, respectively. Loose anagen syndrome may also be misdiagnosed in males, as males traditionally have short hair. 0577af13ef Reactive or adaptive changes to a tumor does not count towards a classification as mixed. Such changes include angiogenesis (blood vessel proliferation) and/or desmoplasia (proliferation of connective tissue). 0577af13ef Pituitary macroadenomas are the most common cause of hypopituitarism. 0577af13ef EDA-A1 and EDA-A2 are two isoforms of ectodysplasin that are encoded by the anhidrotic ectodermal dysplasia (EDA) gene. Mutations in EDA give rise to a clinical syndrome characterized by loss of hair, sweat glands, and teeth. The protein encoded by this gene specifically binds to EDA-A2 isoform. This protein is a type III transmembrane protein of the TNFR (tumor necrosis factor receptor) superfamily, and contains 3 cysteine-rich repeats and a single transmembrane domain but lacks an N-terminal signal peptide. Multiple alternatively spliced transcript variants have been found for this gene, but some variants lack sufficient support. 0577af13ef When present, shovel-shaped incisors can indicate correlation among populations and

are considered to be one of the non-metrical traits in osteology. It is theorized that positive selection for shovel-shaped incisors over spatulate incisors occurred more commonly in cultures that used their teeth as tools, because a more shoveled shape increases structural strength. 0577af13ef Shovel-shaped incisors are significantly common in Indigenous Americans from North, Central, and South America. They are also common in East Asians and Central Asians, Inuit, and Aleut peoples of Northeast Asia and North America (including but not limited to Inuit in eastern Alaska, Arctic Canada, and Greenland). In certain European and African groups, shovel-shaped upper incisors are uncommon or not present. Hay-Wells syndrome is an autosomal dominant pattern of inheritance. The syndrome is thought to arise from a missense mutation in a gene pivotal for the proper development of craniofacial structures and extremities, as well as skin differentiation. Specifically, mutations within the Tumor Protein 63 gene have been implicated in Hay-Wells syndrome. 0577af13ef This gene was identified by its association with ectodermal dysplasia, and specifically with hypohidrotic ectodermal dysplasia, a genetic disorder characterized by defective development of hair, teeth, and eccrine sweat glands. The protein encoded by this gene is a death domain-containing protein, and is found to interact with EDAR, a death domain receptor known to be required for the development of hair, teeth and other ectodermal derivatives. This protein and EDAR are coexpressed in epithelial cells during the formation of hair follicles and teeth. Through its interaction with EDAR, this protein acts as an adaptor, and links the receptor to downstream signaling pathways. Two alternatively spliced transcript variants of this gene encoding distinct isoforms have been reported. 0577af13ef

Most pituitary adenomas are microadenomas and have an estimated prevalence of 16.7% (14.4% in autopsy studies and 22.5% in radiologic studies). The majority of pituitary microadenomas remain undiagnosed, and those that are diagnosed are often found as an incidental finding and are referred to as incidentalomas. 0577af13ef == Function == 0577af13ef Non-invasive and non-secreting pituitary adenomas are considered to be benign in the literal as well as the clinical sense, though a 2011 meta-analysis of available research showed that research to either support or refute this assumption was scant and of questionable quality. 0577af13ef

In those rare cases wherein the dermoid cyst is malignant, a squamous cell carcinoma usually develops in adults, while infants and children usually present with an endodermal sinus tumor. 0577af13ef While pituitary adenomas are common, affecting approximately 1 in... 0577af13ef The most common mediastinal masses are thymoma (20% of mediastinal tumors), usually found in the anterior mediastinum, followed by neurogenic tumor (15–20%) located in the anterior mediastinum. Adults usually present with cancers of the anterior mediastinum and children usually present with cancers of the posterior mediastinum. 0577af13ef
