Tripura's demography underwent a major change as a result of illegal migrants and refugees from former East Bengal and subsequently from Bangladesh. Bangladesh genocide It began on 25 March 1971, as Operation Searchlight was launched by West Pakistan (now Pakistan) to militarily subdue the Bengali population of East Pakistan; the Bengalis comprised the demographic majority and had been calling for independence from the Pakistani state. The Bangladesh genocide was the ethnic cleansing of Bengalis residing in East Pakistan (now Bangladesh) during the Bangladesh Liberation War, perpetrated by the Pakistan Army and the Razakars militia. Seeking to curtail the Bengali self-determination movement, Pakistani president Yahya Khan approved a large-scale military deployment, and in the nine-month-long conflict that ensued, Pakistani soldiers and local pro-Pakistan militias killed between 300,000 and 3,000,000 Bengalis and raped between 200,000 and 400,000 Bengali women in a systematic campaign of mass killing and genocidal sexual violence 827b45d889

Names of Bengal The name Bangla is used by both Bangladesh and West Bengal in international contexts. In 2016, West Bengal Legislative Assembly passed a resolution Bengal is a region in South Asia, politically split between Bangladesh and India. This is the native name of the state, literally meaning “West Bengal” in the Bengali language. Due to its long history and complicated political divisions, various names have been used to refer to the region and its subsections. In the Bengali language, the two Bengals each use a different term to refer to the nominally identified nation: Bāṅlā (বাংলা) and Baṅga (বাংগা) 827b45d889
